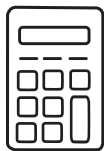

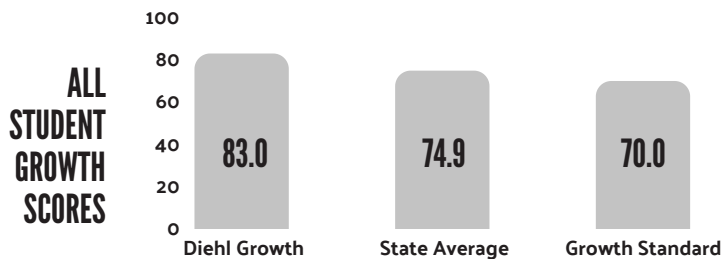

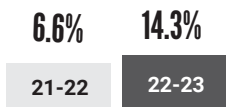
STUDENT GROWTH EXCEEDS STANDARD

DOUBLED THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS DEMONSTRATING GRADE 3 ON-TRACK READING PERFORMANCE

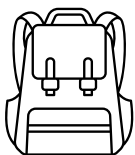
GRADE 3 STUDENTS ON-TRACK

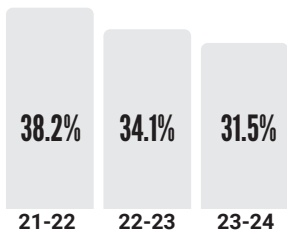


STUDENT ATTENDANCE

IMPROVED REGULAR ATTENDANCE RATE

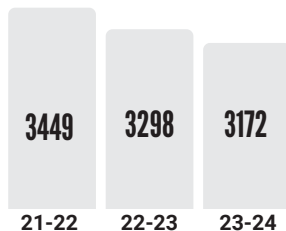
STUDENTS CHRONICALLY ABSENT
