KEY TO SUCCESS



An estimated 64% of Strong Vincent students participate in at least one after-school program each year, one of the highest rates of OST enrollment across the Community School Model. Students have access to robust offerings, with 31 programs taking place in the 23-24 year.

Nearly 70% of Strong Vincent's after-school programs include academic components related to math, science, reading, art or civics..

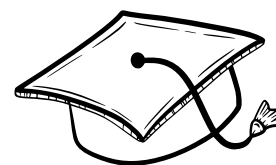


IMPROVED HEALTH AND WELLNESS

INCREASED ACCESS TO BASIC NEEDS AND HEALTH RESOURCES

Strong Vincent has become known for its annual **Health and Wellness Resource Fair**, held in August before the start of school. Over 30 vendors share valuable resources, programs and services with families. In 2023, over 1,200 students and families attended. In addition to the Health and Wellness Fair, last year students in need were able to access:

- hygiene, food, clothing and winter items via the Community Closet
- laundry services via the school's washer and dryer
- vision services and glasses for those with a prescription
- check-ups via a mobile dentist clinic

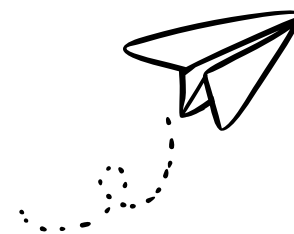


COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS
